Hye-Ohn Park is a distinguished figure in Korean traditional music, holding a Doctor of Musical Arts from Ewha Womans University, where she also earned her Master's and Bachelor's degrees. She has specialized in Daegeum melodies and traditional Korean music, producing significant scholarly work on these subjects.

Currently, Hye-Ohn serves as a lecturer at Ewha Womans University and also lectures at Sungshin Women's University, Chugye University for the Arts, Sookmyung Women's University. She teaches courses on Korean traditional music and various traditional instruments, including Daegeum, Danso, Sogeum, Janggu, and vocal music. Her past roles include leading the Daegeum section of the Ewha Korean Music Orchestra and directing the Korean Court Music Society.

Hye-Ohn's contributions have been recognized with the Kim Hwal-Ran 21st Century Scholarship and the title of Korea National Intangible Cultural Heritage holder for 'Jong Myo Jae Rye Ak.' Her extensive performance career includes domestic recitals featuring her "On the Road" series and numerous international performances across the United States, Europe, and Asia. She has also participated in various cultural exchange programs and charity events worldwide, promoting Korean traditional music globally. Hye-Ohn's dedication to education, research, and performance underscores her significant impact on the field of Korean traditional music.
